Legal framework for Germany

- The Federal Office for Economic Affairs and Export Control is a superior federal authority subordinated to the Federal Ministry of Economics and Energy. It is entrusted with important administrative tasks of the federal government in Foreign Trade, Promotion of Economic Development and SME, Energy, and Auditor Oversight
- "A central task is export control. Being involved in the export control policy of the federal government, Federal Office for Economic Affairs and Export Control is a licensing authority working in close co-operation with other federal agencies on a complex export control system. Within the framework of international and legal commitments, export controls are oriented towards the security need and foreign political interests of the Federal Republic of

Germany."

"Another relevant task of the Federal Office for Economic Affairs and Export Control in the area of foreign trade is to implement the import regulations adopted as part of the European Union's common trade policy."



What it is – and what not!

There is some confusion regarding the capabilities of SAP S/4HANA for international trade

It is **NOT**:

- SAP GTS moved into SAP S/4HANA
- ERP for foreign trade moved into SAP S/4HANA

It IS:

- New development leveraging knowledge of SAP's experienced global trade team
- Opportunity to meet global trade requirements within SAP S/4HANA (part of SAP S/4HANA Core)

SAP S/4HANA for international trade

Scope

Classification for International Trade

- Classification of products with commodity codes and Intrastat service codes
- Classification of products with control classes and control groups for legal control
- Classification of products with customs tariff numbers (also for end-uses)
- Retransfer of commodity codes from SAP GTS to SAP S/4HANA

International Trade Compliance

- Legal Control
 - Control of legal regulations for import and export
 - Managing of licenses in accordance with legal control for import and export processes
 - Managing and release of blocked legal control documents
- Embargo
 - Manage countries under embargo
 - Manage documents
 - Release of blocked documents




- SAP S/4HANA for International Trade is to be set up in customizing under IMG: Governance, Risk and Compliance
- Trade Compliance checks for legal control, embargo and watch list screening can be set up for ...
 - Sales Orders, Sales Contracts, Sales Scheduling Agreements, and Sales Quotation
 - Outbound Deliveries, Inbound Deliveries
 - Purchase Orders, Purchase Contracts, Purchase Requisitions, Purchase Scheduling Agreements






Trade compliance checks along the supply chain

- Trade Compliance checks are performed separately per business document
- For Legal Control, however, the following applies: Once you maintained a classification and licence (e.g. for the sales contract) this regulation then also applies for the subsequent documents as well (inheritance)
- Note: the individual checks could lead to a "mismatch" – e.g. a sales order can be of status "Released" whereas a subsequent delivery will be blocked due to a new embargo or an expired export license at a later time
- For Legal Control, however, the following applies: Once you maintained a classification and licence (e.g. for the sales contract) this regulation then also applies for the subsequent documents as well (inheritance)




- Activate sales document type in two steps:
- First specify the required sales document types for which you want to perform the Trade Compliance Checks
- Secondly specify the company code and select the relevant Trade
 Compliance Check per document type







 Sales order with a Sold-to Party which is located in a country which is defined as being under embargo by legal law




 The sales order retrieves the information and displays the information on header and item detail level



- Enter the respective tile in the Fiori Launchpad
- As per customizing / configuration for embargo the overall status of the sales order is automatically blocked




- On item level the compliance check for embargo display status "Pending"
- There are two options for the trade compliance manager: to confirm or to release the compliance block




The trade compliance manager confirms the block and the trade compliance document get stored



The overall status of the compliance document changes to "Confirm Block"



 Accordingly the sales order displays the result as well

SAP S/4HANA for International Trade & Global Trade Management Relevant Compliance Checks for Global Trade Management

- Trade Compliance Check for Legal Control
- Trade Compliance Check for Embargo
- Trade Compliance Check for Watch List Screening




- With release SAP S/4HANA 2021 (On-Premise) business object "Trading Contract" is part of the trade compliance checks in SAP S/4HANA for International Management (also see <u>SAP Help Portal for SAP S/4HANA Rel. 2021</u>)
- The following Trade Compliance checks can be performed: Watch List Screening, Legal Control, and Embargo
- From a process point of view the trader is able to retrieve an intermediate result from International Management before releasing and saving the document. This offers the ability to check the relevant data already before a trade compliance dept. gets involved into the sales cycle
- Note: a new function module ensures that SAP S/4HANA for International Trade checks whether a sales order and/or purchase order has a trading contract as preceding document
 - if a sales order/purchase has been created the status of the trade compliance check of the trading contract is being inherited into the sales order/purchase order – there is no additional separate trade compliance check for sales/purchase documents
 - in addition no trade compliance documents are being created in SAP S/4HANA for International Trade for the follow-on documents. Only the trade compliance document for the trading contract document is created and stored in International Management

- If the trading contract gets changed after a trade compliance check has been executed (e.g. changes to the delivery address which is under embargo or a subsequent maintenance of a not-allowed material) automatically another trade compliance check is processed again which might lead to a blocking status of separate line items
- A delivery also can not be processed out of a blocked trading contract / sales order since the delivery document incorporates the data from the trading contract
- Note: The deliveries following the sales order will again have a trade compliance check carried out (if enabled) and trade compliance documents will be created


Example: Legal Control


 A Trading Contract contains material TR-MAT-05 which is not allowed to be processed due to legal control and material TR-MAT-01 for which no legal regulation is required



Example: Legal Control

- After maintaining the data the trading contract displays the current status of the relevant compliance check
- Reason: the intermediate result for legal control from SAP S/4HANA for International Trade immediately detects an issue for at least one line item (material TR-MAT-05)
- Since the creation of the follow-on documents havn't been configured to be suppressed the sales order/purchase order can be created






Schedule Line Overview:

- Line item 20 is processed "Pending"






 In the Trading Contract - on item detail level - correspondingly the status information from SAP S/4HANA for International Trade is displayed



Example: Legal Control


- The status in the sales order reflects the same status as the trading contract as it is copied from the Trading Contract (no separate Trade compliance check as in standard behavior)
- Note that there is no corresponding status overview in the purchase order the purchase order changes into "Hold" status







Overall status in Trade Compliance document for Trading Contract 129: Blocked



Example: Legal Control

• Line item 10 is released whereas for inbound and outbound processes of material TR-MAT-05 the trade compliance check indicates that the material is blocked




Example: Legal Control

- There is no classification / licence agreement for material TR-MAT-05. Hence, the trade compliance document (and the Trading Contract) can only be confirmed as "Blocked"
- Alternatively the Trade Compliance Manager can maintain a new/additional licence regulation in order to release the trade compliance document




Example: Legal Control

- Maintenance of licence classification for line item 20 (Inbound) (must be configured in customizing for International Trade beforehand)
- Note: once a licence classification has been maintained it applies for all proceedings/subsequent trade documents (inheritance; standard logic)



Example: Legal Control

Status switches to "Released" for line item 20 (Inbound)





Same procedure applies for item 20 to release the material




Example: Legal Control

The overall status of the trade compliance document has changed to status "Released" accordingly




Example: Legal Control

The status of the Trading Contract gets updated and finally line item 20 can be processed as well



Summary

- SAP S/4HANA for international trade provides key functionality to meet global trade requirements – now also in the area of Global Trade Management
- The Trading Contract itself has been enhanced correspondingly by dedicated functions to integrate SAP S/4HANA for International Trade and to process trade compliance checks smoothly - some logic has been adjusted to match the global trade specific requirements
- Embedded within SAP S/4HANA at no additional cost except for services for Watch List Screening (as of October 2021)
- Two decades of proven global trade experience built into the solution
- Prebuilt integration to market-leading SAP Global Trade Services and SAP Watch List Screening when requirements expand
